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The speakers explained in detail the causes, symptoms, transmission, and treatment of tuberculosis. They highlighted the importance of early diagnosis and adherence to the prescribed treatment regimen. The Nikshay Mitra scheme was introduced to the students, and the role of individuals and communities in supporting TB patients was discussed.

The session was interactive, with students asking insightful questions about TB prevention and how they could contribute as NSS volunteers. The doctors appreciated the enthusiasm of the students and encouraged them to act as ambassadors of health awareness in their communities.
